How do the groups work?

CanaVox groups are designed to generate positive, forward-thinking discussion about the pressing issues concerning marriage in our culture.

Each month, the CanaVox reading groups will gather in a room in the Pastoral Center to discuss the readings for that month's session topic. The readings are read in advance and then discussed during the meeting.

How much reading will there be?

The readings (some videos included) are designed to be concise so that they can reasonably be completed during the month in between discussion sessions. Even if you aren't able to complete all the readings before the meeting, the discussion groups are structured so that conversation will be fruitful even if everyone couldn't complete all the reading.
