(Mark 15:33-39) Jesus knows what it's like to suffer, grieve, and feel abandoned by God. He too cried out, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

Let us pray that Christ may draw near and comfort those who are grieving and that his nearness may bring them freedom and peace. Let us also pray that Christ who died for us, may admit those who have died into his eternal garden in heaven.

Let us pray that Christ may free the loved ones of the addicted from feelings of shame, blame, and guilt and that he may grant them the grace to be courageous in the face of their challenges.
