

To Obtain a Plenary Indulgence During the Jubilee Year 2025

Conditions for Each Indulgence:

- 1. Be truly repentant and free from any attachment to sin
- 2. Receive the Sacrament of Penance
- 3. Received Holy Communion on the same day you seek the indulgence
- 4. Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father

Ways to Obtain the Plenary Indulgence:

1. Pilgrimage to a Sacred Jubilee Site

- Visit any designated sacred Jubilee site and devoutly participate in Holy Mass
- Engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with:
 - Our Father
 - o Profession of Faith (in any approved form)
 - o Invocations to Mary, the Mother of God, so that all may experience her closeness during this Holy Year.

Performance of a Work of Mercy - Corporal or Spiritual

- Engage in acts of charity and mercy, such as:
 - o Corporal:
 - Visit the sick
 - Feed the hungry
 - Give drink to the thirst
 - Shelter the homeless
 - Visit the prisoners
 - Bury the dead
 - Give alms to the poor
 - o Spiritual:
 - Counseling the doubtful
 - Instructing the ignorant
 - Admonishing the sinner
 - Comforting the sorrowful
 - Forgiving injuries
 - Bearing wrongs patiently
 - Praying for the living and the dead

Participation in Spiritual Formation

- Attend popular missions, spiritual exercises, or formation activities focused on:
 - The documents of the Second Vatican Council
 - The Catechism of the Catholic Church

- Follow celebrations through available media (broadcasts by the Pope or their diocesan bishop).
- Recite the Our Father, the Profession of Faith (in any approved form), and other prayers reflecting the spirit of the Holy Year.
- Offer up their sufferings or hardships as a spiritual sacrifice.

By following these steps with a sincere heart, the faithful can fully experience the graces of the Jubilee Year 2025.
